




















Economic Forecast

- EU integration Until 2030
- According to the IMF forecasts in the period 2025-2029, the GDP of the Republic of Moldova will grow on average by approximately 5% per year, a much faster pace than the regional average estimated at 3% per year
- In the next 5 years, the Republic of Moldova will have the highest economic growth in the region and will surpass Armenia, Belarus, Georgia, North Macedonia and Albania in terms of Gross Domestic Product per capita








